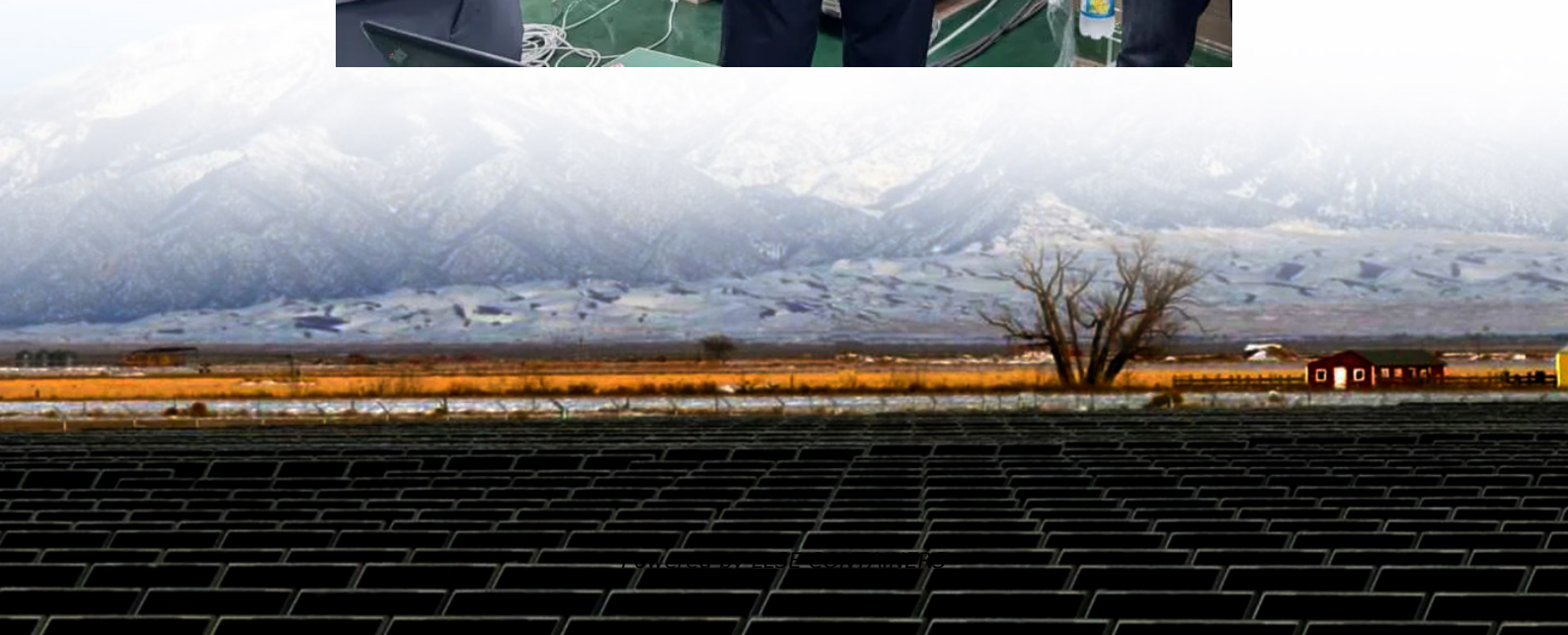


China portable power station in Zimbabwe





Overview

What is the largest power station in Zimbabwe?

Situated in the North Western part of Zimbabwe, Hwange Power Station is the largest coal-fired power station with 920MW installed capacity which comprises of 4x120MW and 2x220 MW units. In 1955, it was decided to dam the Zambezi River at the Kariba Gorge to supply power to Zimbabwe and Zambia.

Who owns Zimbabwe Power Station?

It is owned and operated by the national electricity company Zimbabwe Electricity Supply Authority. It was built in two stages and consists of 4 units of 120 MW each, 2 units of 220 MW each and 2 units of 300 MW each. Engineering Consultants, Merz & McLellan, were employed for the design and supervision of the construction of the power station.

What's new at Hwange thermal power station?

HWANGE, Zimbabwe -- Zimbabwean President Emmerson Mnangagwa on Thursday commissioned the Chinese-funded Hwange Thermal Power Station expansion project in Hwange, about 780 km from the capital Harare. Chinese firm Sinohydro undertook the expansion, adding two new generators, Unit 7 and Unit 8, to the existing six units at the power plant.

What is the power source in Zimbabwe?

The power source in Zimbabwe is sourced from local generation and imports. Local generation comes from Kariba Hydropower, Hwange coal-fired power Station, and three small thermal power plants. Domestic generation comes from Kariba Hydropower, Hwange coal-fired power Station, and three small thermal power plants. Supplementary power is imported from Mozambique, Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), and Zambia.
