

Sound insulation under solar glass





Overview

How does insulated glass help with sound insulation?

Insulated glass is an ideal window and door material which significantly helps in counteracting noise pollution. The presence of air space or gas-filled cavity in between two panes of glass provides better sound insulation.

Is thicker glass better for sound insulation?

The thicker the glass, the better the sound insulation properties. The further the sound has to travel through the glass, the more sound waves will drop off. Thicker glass is a common solution to reduce low frequency sounds like common traffic and neighbourhood noise. It is especially effective when combined with double glazing.

What are acoustically insulated glass blocks?

Glass blocks in the Technology Line from Seves are acoustically insulated, isolating environments and reducing background noise up to 49 dB to meet international sound noise limits.

What are soundproof glass blocks?

Sound proof glass blocks are the preferred material in noisy environments, such as discos and manufacturing facilities, due to their ability to provide optimum insulation against sound. They also offer creativity and aesthetics. Energy saving glass blocks are a type of soundproof glass blocks that can reduce the thermal transmittance of the glass block by up to 50%.

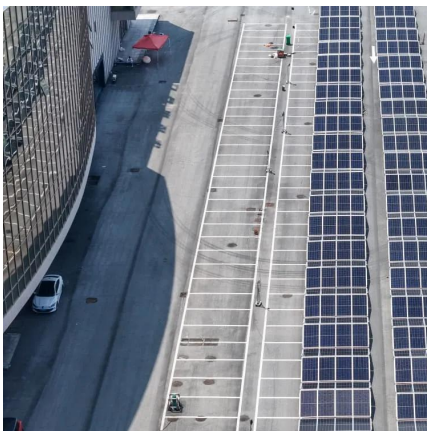
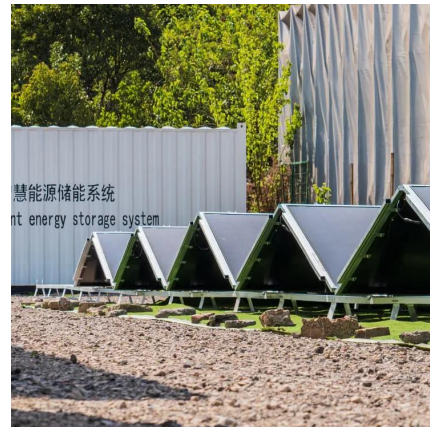

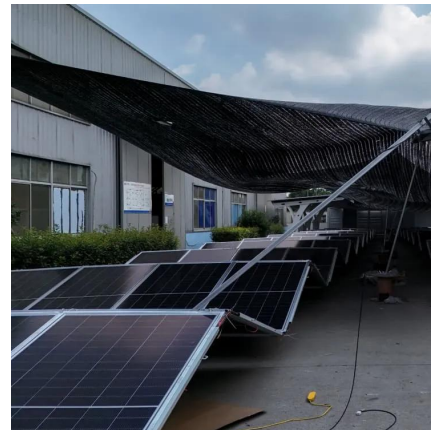
